WHAT IS SDCIAA?

The San Diego Crime and Intelligence Analysis Association (SDCIAA), established in 1987, is a regional organization concerned with the development and enhancement of crime and intelligence analysis as a tool in law enforcement.

SDCIAA's purpose is to:

- Provide a regional organization for law enforcement professionals to share crime and intelligence analysis information.
- Enhance knowledge of crime and intelligence analysis techniques and innovations in analysis.
- Encourage the sharing of member expertise.

SDCIAA's membership is comprised of professionals involved or interested in the areas of crime and intelligence analysis. As a crime analysis association, SDCIAA works with other regional crime analysis organizations throughout the state, and is a member of the <u>California Crime and</u> Intelligence Analysis Association (CCIAA).

PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES

Association meetings:

An exchange of information, presentations and training on topics related to law enforcement.

Training:

Training sessions are held on various pertinent and timely crime and intelligence analysis topics.

Career Information:

An opportunity to be informed regarding job openings, professional networks, career opportunities, training and other job-related resources.

Conference:

SDCIAA periodically hosts the statewide crime and intelligence analysis conference.

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

The San Diego Crime and Intelligence Analysis Association is presided over by the Executive Board. The Executive Board formulates the plans and policies of the association, and provides administrative leadership and support.

Committees are involved in Training Development and Program Content, Recruitment and Membership, and By-Laws Review and Audit.

All members receive minutes of meetings and a membership directory, which is a valuable resource.

Officers are elected every two years. All members are encouraged to become active in the association.

Annual SDCIAA membership dues are due January 1st of each year and the membership term runs from January 1st through December 31st of each year.


